

DISTRICT GOALS 2011-2012

1. Through feedback from the Community and the Board of Education, develop a recommended capital project that is operationally and educationally beneficial to the District, while being financially responsible; present, publicize and promote the Capital project prior to a public vote; and if approved, work with all external required entities appropriately to begin the implementation of the project.
2. Develop, negotiate and implement a new evaluation system for both teachers and principals that complies with the new APPR mandates
3. Facilitate the implementation of the three goals recommended by the Educational System Review Process. They are:
 - The district will collect, analyze and use multiple data sources to make informed decisions.
 - The district will implement a formal process for collaboration of data by staff both vertically and horizontally to drive instructional decisions to improve student achievement.
 - The district will design and implement an instructional action plan of rigor, relevance, and 21st century skills; using analysis, interpretation of data, and alignment to the Common Core Learning Standards.
4. Explore and implement opportunities for greater efficiencies and shared services at all levels within our district and with other school districts to minimize costs and maximize student learning.
