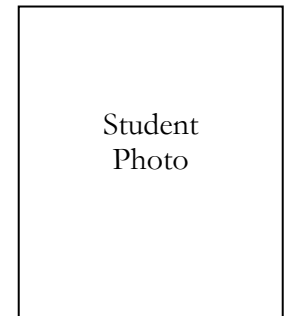

SYMPTOMS OF A SEIZURE EPISODE MAY INCLUDE ANY/ALL OF THESE:

- Tonic-Clonic Seizure:
 - o Entire body stiffens, jerking movements
 - o May cry out, turn bluish, be tired afterwards
- Absence Seizure:
 - o Staring spell, may blink eyes

TREATMENT:

Clear the area around the student to avoid injury.
DO NOT PUT ANYTHING IN THE STUDENT'S MOUTH
 Place student on side if possible, speak to student in reassuring tone
 Stay with student until help arrives

 Preferred Hospital if transported: _____
