It is understood that the student accepting this privilege will abide by the following conditions:

1. The student must register the vehicle with the school.
2. Once the vehicle is parked in the morning, it is to be locked and not used for any purpose during the school day. Students may not leave school before dismissal unless they receive permission from the House Principal or Secondary Principal.
3. Violators of school rules and policies will result in revocation of driving privilege.
4. Students who fail two or more classes will lose their driving privilege until the next grade report is completed.
5. Any use of the vehicle that results in violation of State traffic laws or reckless endangerment to students or Duaneburg School system will result in revocation of the driving privilege.
6. Any student who is tardy five or more times during a marking period will temporarily lose their parking privilege:

1st Offense – Loss of parking privilege for two weeks

2nd Offense – Loss of parking privilege for four weeks

3rd Offense – Loss of parking privilege for the remainder of the school year.
