

Senior Privilege

Late Arrival / Early Dismissal Permission Slips

My son/daughter, _____, has my permission for late arrival or early dismissal (only one can be chosen).

Late arrival to school, (period 2, 9:01am), and early dismissal from school, (period 11, 2:15pm) is a senior privilege. Student handbook states:

This privilege was set up for seniors with first or eleventh period study halls and approved by the 1993-94 Student Council. If in a senior's original schedule, he or she has 11th period study hall the senior may leave after 10th period. In order to take advantage of this privilege, he/she must obtain a signed permission slip from the principal and have a 70% or above in all subject areas. If this privilege is to be used, the senior must sign in at the office upon late arrival or sign out at the office upon early dismissal. Schedules cannot be rearranged for this privilege.

It is understood that students granted this privilege must abide by the following conditions:

1. Student must fill out and return this form along with a copy of his/her progress report.
2. Student must have a passing average of 70 or above in all classes.
3. Student must sign in or out at the Attendance Secretary's desk the time they enter or leave school
4. Student arriving late must be on time for period 2. Failure to arrive on time for second period class more than 3 times a semester will lose this privilege.
5. Student must leave school grounds immediately upon signing out and not loiter in the area. Failure to comply with this rule will jeopardize this privilege.
6. If student's average drops to failing, this privilege is automatically revoked until the average is raised to passing.
7. If student fails a subject, they will lose this privilege for the next marking period following.
