You are invited to participate in the ninth annual "Duanesburg Day" on Saturday, March 3, 2012, from 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. at Duanesburg Middle/High School located on Route 395 in the heart of Delanson. Our snow date will be Sunday, March 4th, from 12:00 to 5:00 p.m.

Our theme this year is "A Community of Helping Hands". All those attending are asked to bring a non-perishable food item to be donated to and divided between three local food pantries. We will highlight our local first responders who have worked especially hard this year due to Hurricane Irene.

Duanesburg Day is a community celebration to recognize our local heritage and culture of the past, present and future. Duanesburg Day festivities will include a wide variety of events appealing to all age groups and interests. There will be a craft fair, antique dealers, hands-on activities, performances, student historical and art displays, community groups and local business information booths, delicious food and much more.

Outside vendors will be required to provide their own table for one 8 foot space. ***We must have your registration form in our possession no later than February 17, 2012.*** We will not be able to fill requests received after that date.

Please complete and return the registration form on the back of this letter as soon as possible to secure your space in this event. ***You may register more than one group or organization but please submit a separate form for each.*** Feel free to share this letter and registration information with other crafters, antique dealers, groups, etc. that fit our theme of culture and heritage.

We will mail you a map of your table location on or before February 28th. You may set up on the day of Duanesburg Day between 8:00 and 10:00 a.m. on March 3 and if we need to use the snow date, between 10:00 am and 12:00 noon on March 4.
