

Duanesburg Central School District Public Comment Protocols

As per Board of Education policy 1510, Public Expression at Board of Education meetings is encouraged.

- The Public Comment section is an opportunity for residents (and residents only) to address the Board of Education.
- This public expression should take place only in the portion of the agenda designated. This is usually at the beginning of each meeting.
- Persons wishing to address the Board shall indicate their desire to speak in advance on the sign in sheet.
- In order to give everyone who wishes ample opportunity to speak, speakers should confine their comments to three minutes.
- The Board will not address specific questions/comments, but may ask for your name and address in the event follow-up is necessary.
- The Board will not permit in public session discussion involving individual personnel or students. Persons wishing to discuss matters involving individual personnel or students should present their comments and/or concerns to the Superintendent, who will share them with the Board at the next executive session.
